



## Build an insect house

Bundles of tubes are very successful in providing somewhere for insects to lay eggs or to hibernate in.

The hollow stems of bamboo or hogweed are an ideal natural resource but large plastic drinking

straws are an artificial (if not very eco-friendly) option. Gather tubes into a bundle and secure together with string or wire. Ensure one end is

blocked off so the tubes do not become a wind tunnel.

A catering sized coffee tin will do the job well.
